### Massachusetts Sheltered English Immersion Teacher Course

Starts on January 8, 2019

Individuals who need or want to earn the SEI endorsement may pay to enroll in SEI Endorsement course through MATSOL, a provider approved by Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education. This for-cost course covers the exact same curriculum as the Department's no-cost course, is taught by instructors who have been vetted and trained by the Department. This course is an approved pathway to SEI Endorsement for:

- Any core academic teacher working with English learners.
- Educators who failed their endorsement course the first time around.
- Educators who, for personal reasons, did not avail themselves of no-cost SEI teacher courses when they were available.
